Ghosts and goblins, witches too, In the night, they spook and boo. Bats take flight, owls hoot and call, As the harvest moon begins to fall.


Jack-o'-lanterns with eerie grins, Flickering candles from within. Haunted houses with creaking doors, Each step you take, the heart implores.


Candy corn and caramel sweets, As trick-or-treaters roam the streets. Their bags grow heavy with sugary haul, Laughter and delight, the best of all.
