To fetch a pail of water;

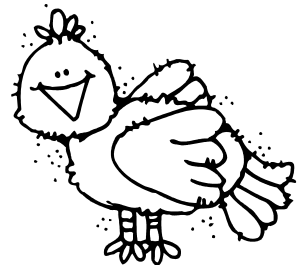
Tishoo, tishoo,
