(Ain't it Great to be Crazy)

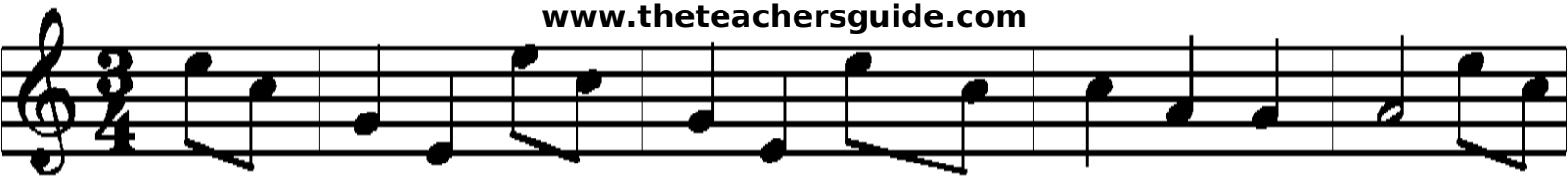
A horse and a flea and three blind mice
