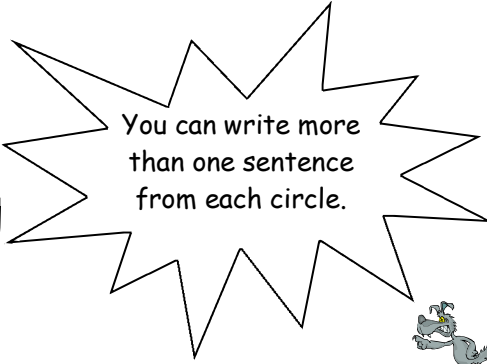

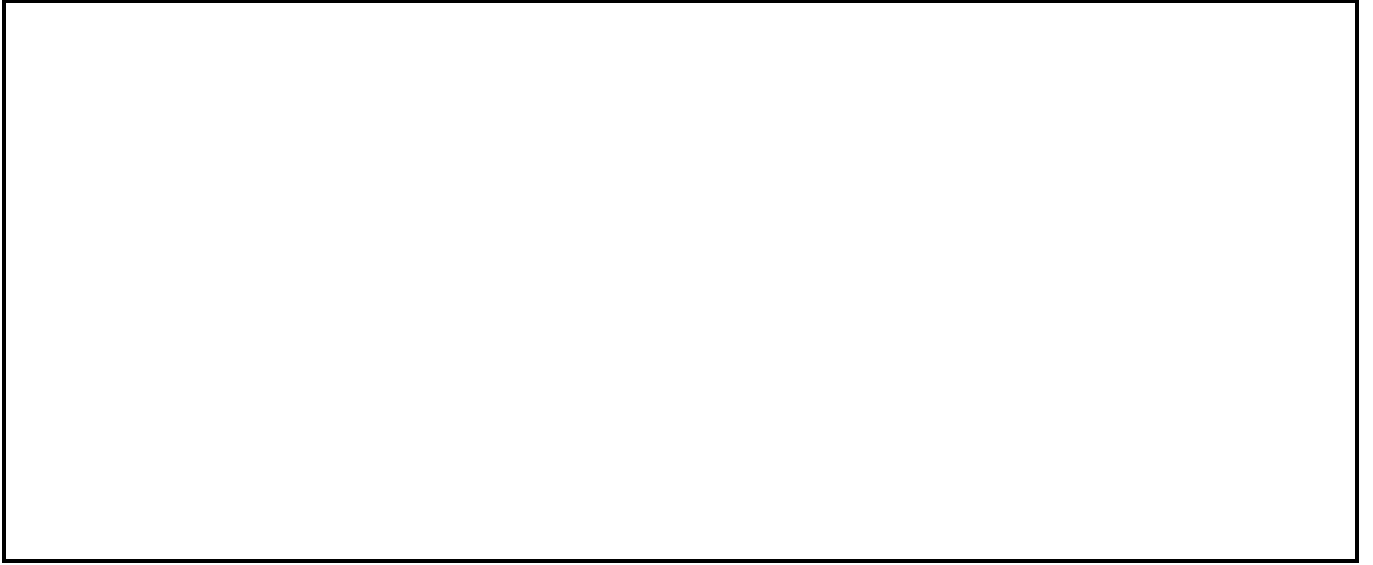
Now copy the first sentence (or two) from the previous page. Use the rest of your answers to write more sentences. Come up with additional ideas on your own.
