(Children hold hands and dance around in a circle)

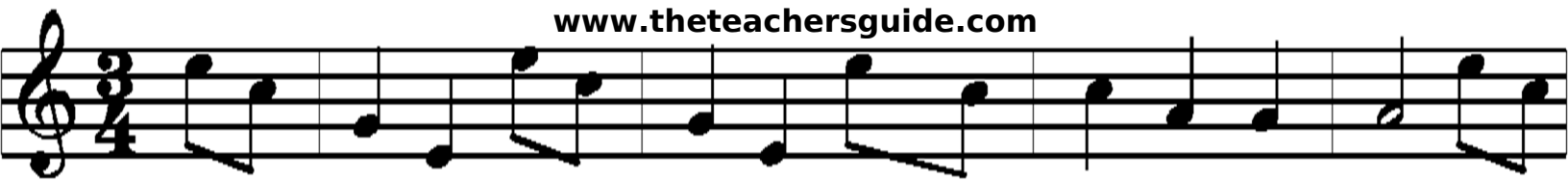
Tishoo, tishoo,
