

Daily Temperatures Graph

Let your students graph the daily temperatures. The graph can be used several different ways.

-Use one graph for each month. The temperature should be checked from the same source at the same time of day. Alternately, you can write down the official high temperature from the previous day.

-Use one graph for two or three months. The students can use a different colored pencil for each month to see the differences in daily temperature. They should write the name of the months at the top with the color they are using to make the graph.

Example: If using red to plot the daily temperatures of December, use red to write December at the top of the page.

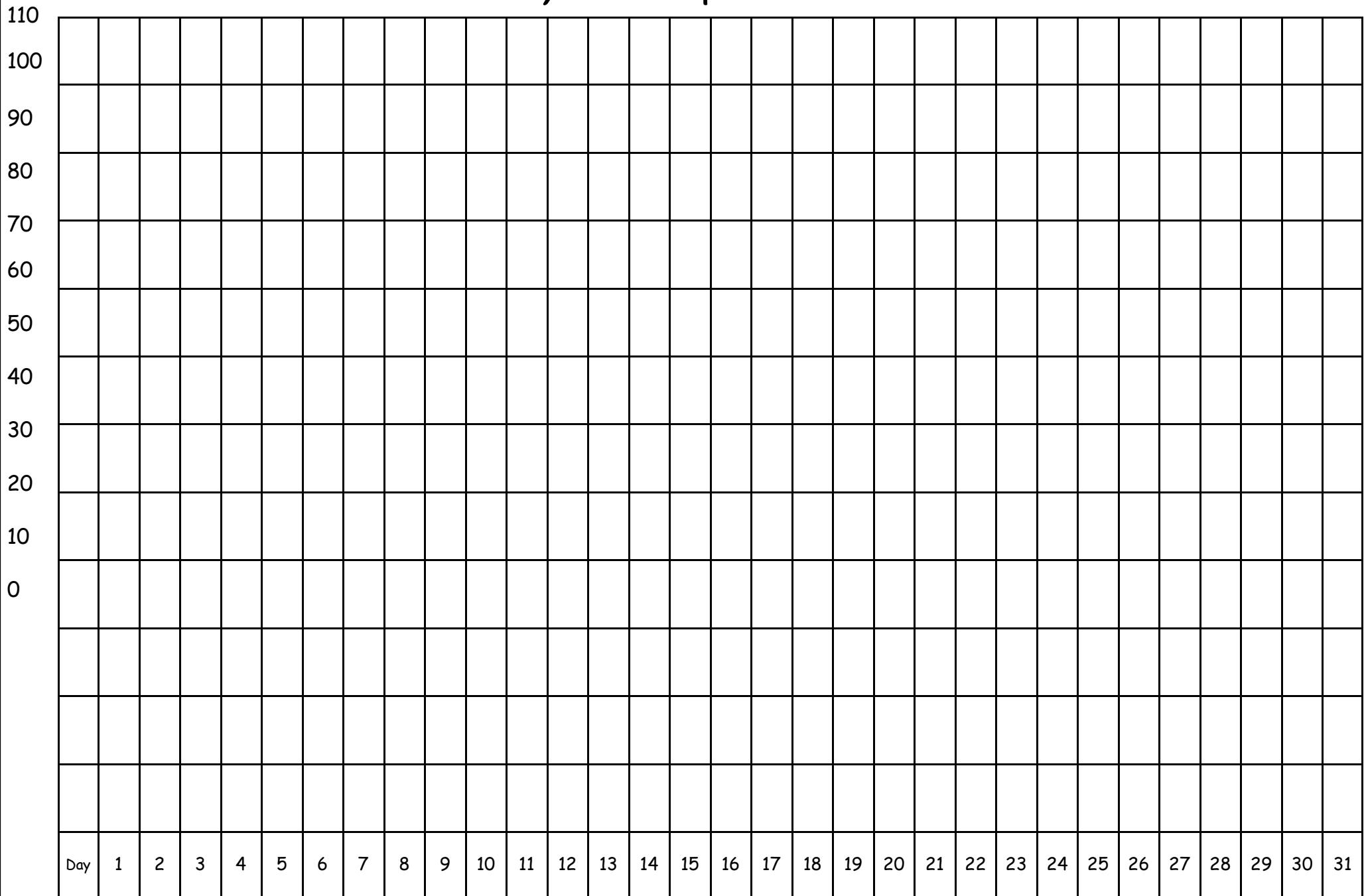
-I have also included different pages for each month if you prefer to use those instead.

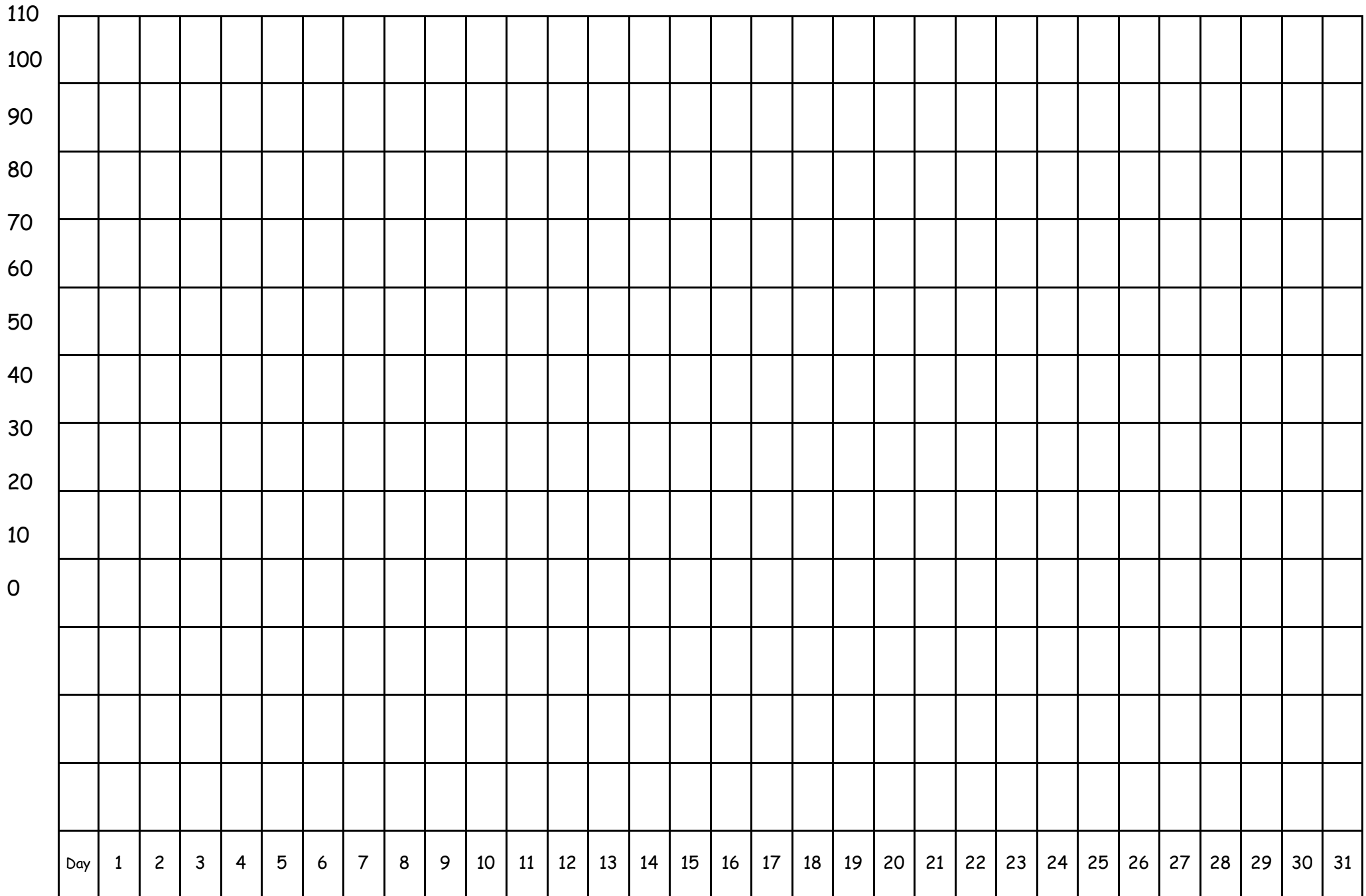
September Daily Temperatures

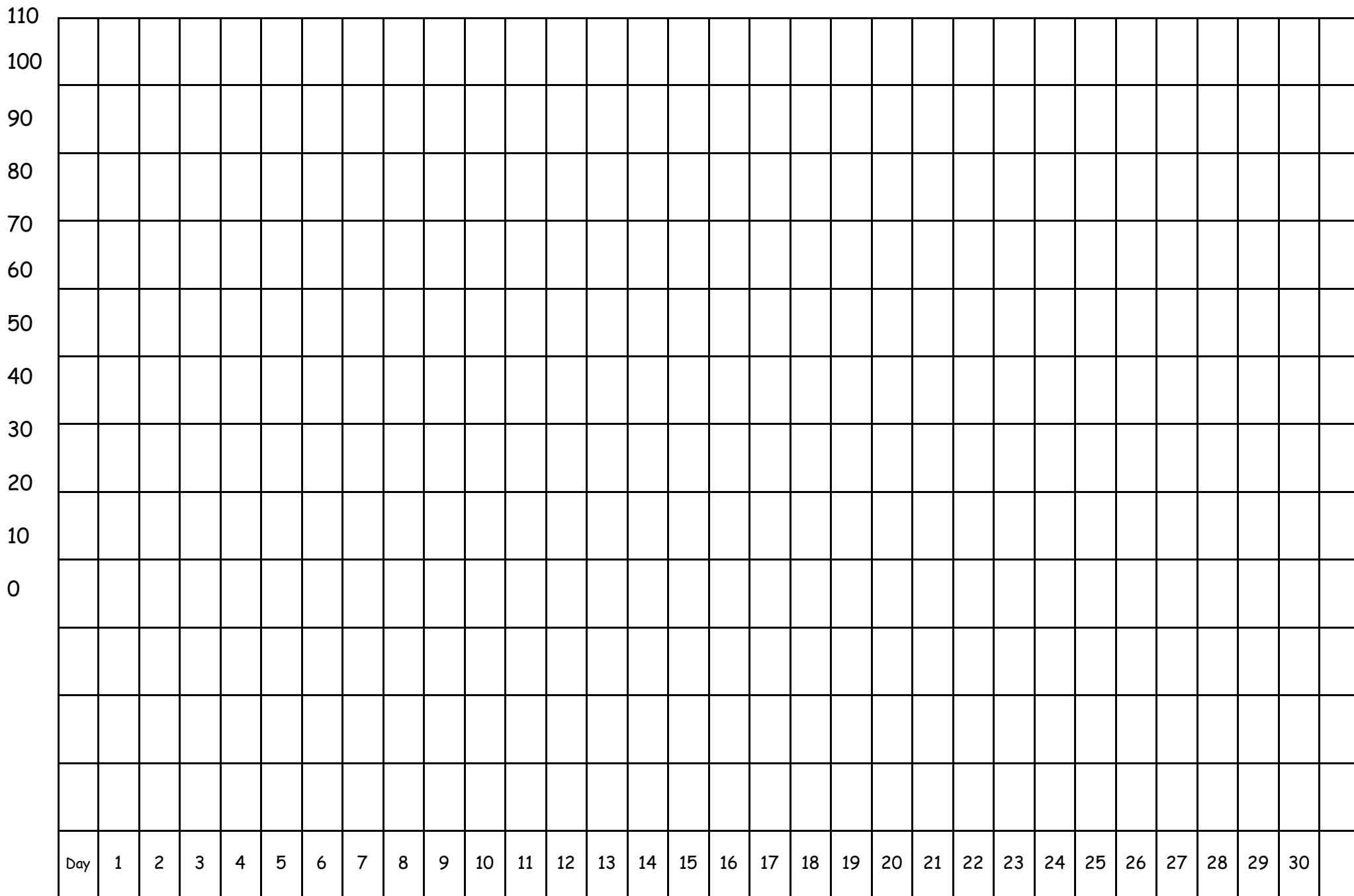
